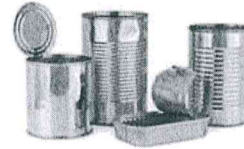
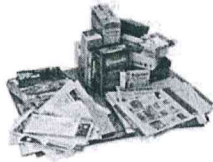




ITEMS ACCEPTED CURBSIDE FOR RECYCLING

Commercial or Agricultural Hazardous Wastes
Non-residential Hazardous Wastes
Automotive Batteries (*Recycle at Retailer*)
Explosives, Flares and Munitions
Tires
Non-Hazardous Recyclable Materials
Unsorted Solid Waste
Radioactive Materials
Empty Aerosol Cans (*Put in Recycling Bin*)
Propane Cylinders / Tanks
Electronic Equipment -*no computers, TVs, etc*
Batteries
(E-waste & Batteries-*Bring to County Transfer Station for recycling*)
